

DIRECTIONS

PROPANE GRIDDLE

1. MAKE SURE ALL 3 VALVES ON GRILL ARE SHUT.
2. TWIST KNOB ON PROPANE TANK TO TURN GAS.
3. **WAIT 15 - 20 SECONDS!** THIS IS VERY IMPORTANT, IT PRESSURIZES THE HOSE.
4. START AT THE VALVE FURTHEST FROM WHERE THE HOSE CONNECTS TO THE GRILL AND OPEN IT ALL THE WAY.
5. USING A LONG TRIGGER LIGHTER, WORK YOUR WAY DOWN, LIGHTING ONE BURNER AT A TIME.
6. AFTER 4-5 MINUTES, TURN THE VALVES DOWN BY $\frac{1}{3}$ TO $\frac{1}{2}$ TO ACHIEVE DESIRED COOKING TEMPERATURES.
7. YOU CAN RUN GRILL WITH VALVES WIDE OPEN IF PREFERRED.

PROPANE

IF USING A 30# PROPANE BOTTLE:

IF RUNNING GRILL WITH VALVES WIDE OPEN, FIGURE ABOUT 4 HOURS OF USE.

IF RUNNING WITH VALVES AT $\frac{1}{3}$ TO $\frac{1}{2}$ OPEN, FIGURE ABOUT 5-9 HOURS OF USE.

IF USING A 40# PROPANE BOTTLE:

IF RUNNING GRILL WITH VALVES WIDE OPEN, FIGURE ABOUT 5.37 HOURS OF USE.

IF RUNNING WITH VALVES AT $\frac{1}{3}$ TO $\frac{1}{2}$ OPEN, FIGURE ABOUT 7-12 HOURS OF USE.
